- Food Vendors are by invitation only so we may provide event attendees with a variety of foods without duplication. We ask that each Food Vendor sells a Burger or a spin on a Burger.
- Booth location will be provided the day of the event.
- Booth spaces are 10' x 10'. You must provide your own tables, chairs & electrical cords. Tents are highly recommended.
- For insurance purposes, a copy of your food license or your FEID# must accompany this application before event.
- Generators must be placed strategically to try and avoid noise and fumes interfering with attendees or other vendors.
- Hawking is not allowed in the street per city ordinance. Selling/display behind table only
- No beverages may be for sale or to be given away.
- Only the items you list below may be sold. Any new items you wish to sell must be approved.
- Set up begins at 11:30 a.m. and booths must be ready to open by 1:00 p.m.
- Booths may not be broken down until 9:00 p.m. at the close of the event.

You will be inspected by the IRC Fire Department before 1:00 p.m. and must meet the requirements listed below

- TENTS: Per Florida Code All tents shall have a Flame Retardant or Resistant Certificate (Tag or Paperwork)
- FIRE EXTINGUISHERS: All Food Vendors are required to have- One minimum 5 lb ABC (2A10B C) currently tagged/inspected or within a year of its manufacture date is required for each vendor. Fire Extinguishers shall be visible and readily available for use. Class K-Type extinguishers are required for vendors that are frying

Exhaust shall be directed away from combustible material(s), people and/or animals. Spare fuel shall be stored in an approved container at a safe distance from generator. NO HOT FUELING. ELECTRIC: wiring and lighting shall be free of damage. All electrical equipment shall be isolated from the occupants/general public in a safe manner. All electrical connections and devices shall be in approved enclosures. COOKING: All food cooking concession trucks, trailers and structures of rigid construction must have a currently tagged commercial ventilation, and extinguishment/suppression systems per NFPA 96 requirements. Code References: Florida Fire Prevention Code (FFPC), NFPA 1, NFPA 96, NFPA 70, NFPA 101, & NFPA 102. I have read, understood, and will comply with all items listed above.
